

Alternative Fall Semester Plan for Visa-Delayed Students

To better support students impacted by delayed visa appointments or extended application review timelines, WashU Olin Business School will offer a delayed start date of **October 20** for four of our specialized master's programs. Students will have the same internship and career opportunities over the duration of their program and will retain their anticipated December 2026 graduation date.
